In accordance with Village of Gowanda Local Law 1-2015 Section 45-10 any customer who wishes to install and utilize a private fire protection service must follow the provisions of this section.

All such customers must file a written application with the Village office. The staff receiving said application will be responsible to provide a copy within five (5) days of receipt of application to the Superintendent and all members of the Board of Trustees for their consideration. The application must contain all documentation as outlined in Section 45-10.1

The Village Board after consideration and discussion with the Superintendent, Village Engineer and any additional consultants they deem appropriate to give guidance on these matters, will formally consider and vote on all such special connections at their next Village Board Meeting.

Written notification of the Village Board's decision and a copy of any adopted resolutions pertaining to said application will be provided to the customer by the Village Clerk within fifteen (15) days of the date of adoption.

In the event that such an application is approved, the Village has the right to discontinue or disconnect the service and terminate the application after fifteen (15) days written notice. It will be the responsibility of the Superintendent to provide said notice to the customer as per section 45-10.3(j).

In the event the special connection is to be used for any purpose other than for the extinguishment of fire the customer must make written application and secure written consent from the Village Board of Trustees before any other use shall be permitted per section 45-10.4.
